While general literature reviews are not acceptable, we welcome meta-analyses or rigorous systematic reviews of original yoga research literature. Case study abstracts are also welcome. Authors with a background in Ayurveda, Yoga, Integrative Healthcare, and/or Scientific Research are all encouraged to submit.

Abstracts must include unpublished research data analyses. Abstracts based on analyses that have been formally published by the abstract date will not be accepted. Abstracts based on secondary and additional analyses on existing data are acceptable even if the data have been published. However, abstracts that describe study design and methods for well-developed and/or funded studies may be considered for poster presentation depending on abstract quality.

All abstracts will be anonymously peer reviewed, scored and chosen on merit for poster presentation during ICIM-2020. Top accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement in the Journal of Integrative Medicine Case Reports, which will be available to all participants.

Individuals whose abstracts are selected will be required to register for the meeting. Abstracts from authors who do not register will not be accepted.
